## 2021 Alyeska Coors Light Town League Race Series Information and Rules

- Open to anyone 21 years of age or older
- **Location:** Race Trail
- **Race Days** are Thursdays starting January 14<sup>th</sup> through February 25<sup>th</sup>.
- **In the event of a race cancellation due to weather there is a make up race date is Thursday, March 4<sup>th</sup>.**
- **Race Hours:** 4 pm – 5pm practice course, 5pm – 8 pm racing.
- During **inclement weather**, or if you suspect postponement, check the online snow report or call the Alyeska Hotline @ 754-7669 for event status.
- You may race as an individual or as part of a team. **Teams** are made up of 7 individuals from any division, with both males and females represented. Team scores are determined by the top five individual point results from a team. If both sexes are not represented team points will be zero for that week.
- The race is a dual format with competitors completing one run each on the red and blue courses. Your best time counts towards your overall placing.
- **Divisions:** Alpine, Telemark and Snowboarding
- **Fees:** The cost is \$100 per racer which includes pre-race practice, 7 races, event t-shirt and end of series awards.
- **Rules:**
  - Absolutely no temporary substitutions are allowed. Permanent substitutions require prior race committee approval. If the race committee learns of a substitution the offending team will receive zero points for that week.
  - Straddling or missing a gate is a DQ. Town League gate judging for the most part is on the honor system, if you miss a gate please inform the race crew.
  - If you sign up as a telemarker, you will be expected to make a telemark turn. (Drop your knee with one foot behind the other).
  - We do not use race bibs. You will be assigned a number at the first race. Please remember your number to help simplify time keeping. However, if you should forget your number please ask race crew to confirm, do not guess as you may be using someone else's number.
  - There is no start order. You may race anytime between 5pm and 8pm. The course is closed promptly at 8pm.
- **Individual Scoring:** Points will be awarded according to the World Cup point schedule:

1 <sup>st</sup> place = 50 points	4 <sup>th</sup> place = 38 points	7 <sup>th</sup> place = 32 points
2 <sup>nd</sup> place = 45 points	5 <sup>th</sup> place = 36 points	8 <sup>th</sup> place = 30 points
3 <sup>rd</sup> place = 40 points	6 <sup>th</sup> place = 34 points	9 <sup>th</sup> place = 29 points

The remainder of the field descends in one point increments. Everyone who starts will be awarded one point.
- **Division placement:** After the first race individuals will be placed in their respective division (A, B, C) based on their best time. To prevent sandbagging, any individual who is considerably faster the second week of racing will be placed in the division that best represents their race time.
- **Team Scoring:** Team scores are determined by the top five individual point results; at least one result must be female.
- **Results:** Results are available usually no later than 9pm or at the Events Office. Results are posted on the Alyeska Resort website usually by Friday afternoon.
- **Prizes** All who race are entered in a drawing for prizes at the final party. You must be present to win or have someone delegated to collect your prize.
- **Awards:** At the conclusion of the series, awards will be presented to the top three individuals in each division and to the top three teams.
